Note: Undertake Ground Penetrating Radar (GPR) throughout undeveloped cemetery area to determine location of any unmarked graves before new areas of the cemetery are developed.

- Drone aerial (flown 29.11.2022) & site visit
- On-site measurements
- GIS data provided by BSC & open source data
