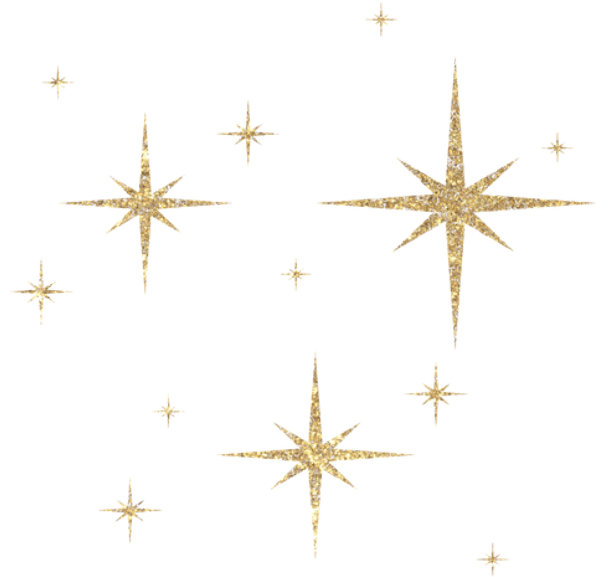


Hark the herald Angels sing

(Straight in)

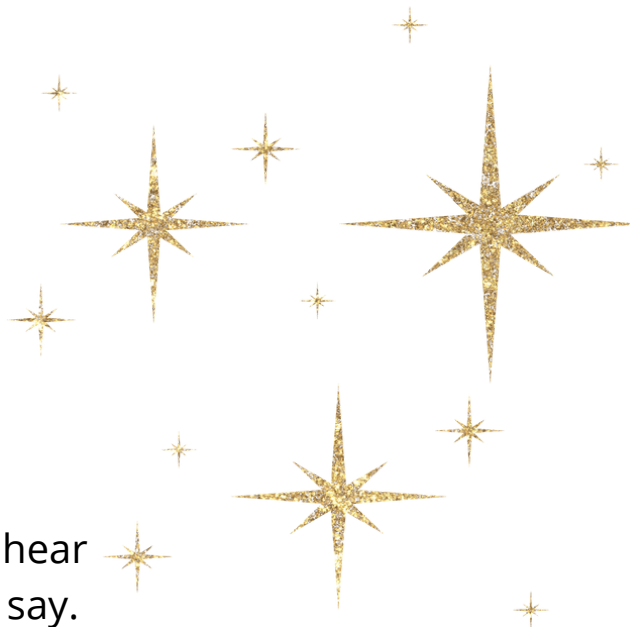
Said the Shepherd boy to the mighty king

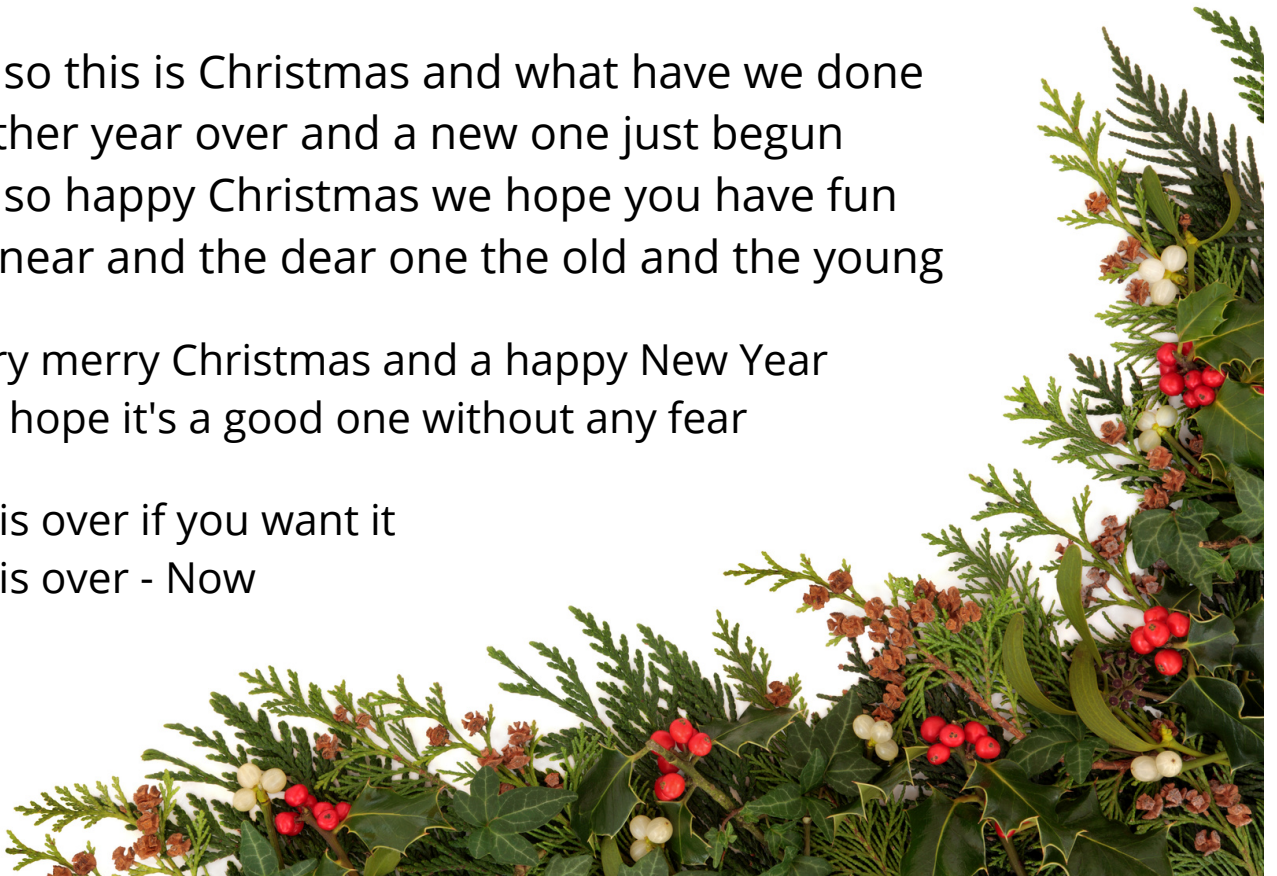
