

# Road work on Newell Highway at Finley

## Notification letter

May 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW (Transport) and Berrigan Shire Council are working together on road surface and safety improvements to the Newell Highway at Finley.

### What work are we doing?

We're carrying out road and safety improvements on the Newell Highway (Murray Street) at Finley. Work includes:

- resurfacing the travel lanes between Ulupna and Wollamai streets to make a smoother, safer road
- relocating the pedestrian crossing from near Pinnuck Street intersection to 50 metres further north along Murray Street to improve safety.

### When and where we'll be working

We'll be working on a 440-metre section of the Newell Highway, between Ulupna and Wollamai streets.

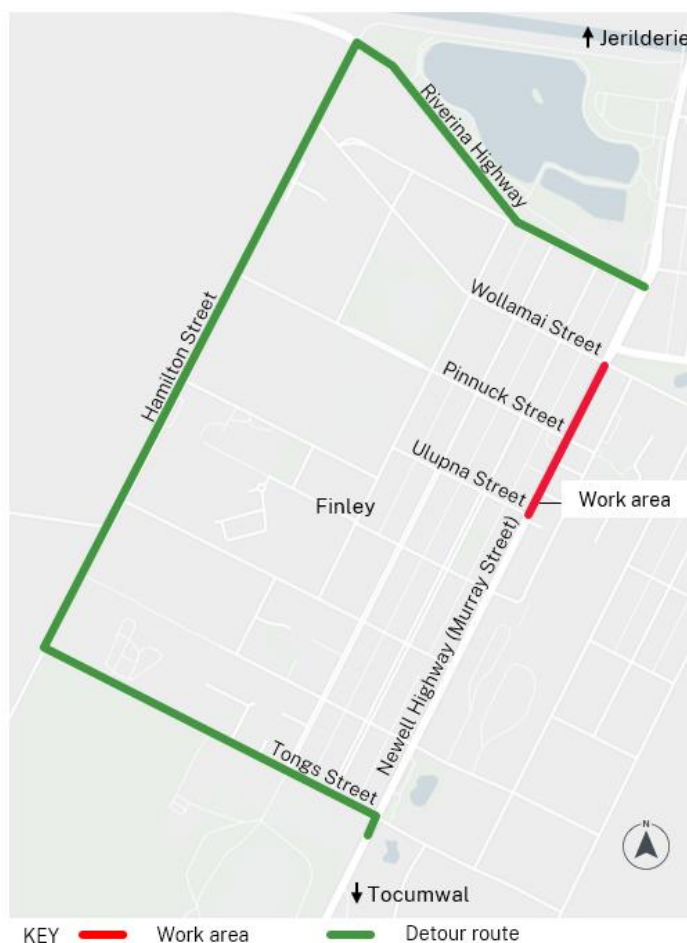
To limit community impacts, Transport's work will be carried out in a mixture of day and night shifts from **Friday 16 May**. Work is expected to take up to two weeks, weather permitting. Berrigan Shire Council will carry out work on the new pedestrian crossing from early June. This work is expected to be complete by late June.

### What will this mean for you?

A work schedule to reduce impacts on the community has been developed following

community and business consultation in late 2024.

### Location of work area

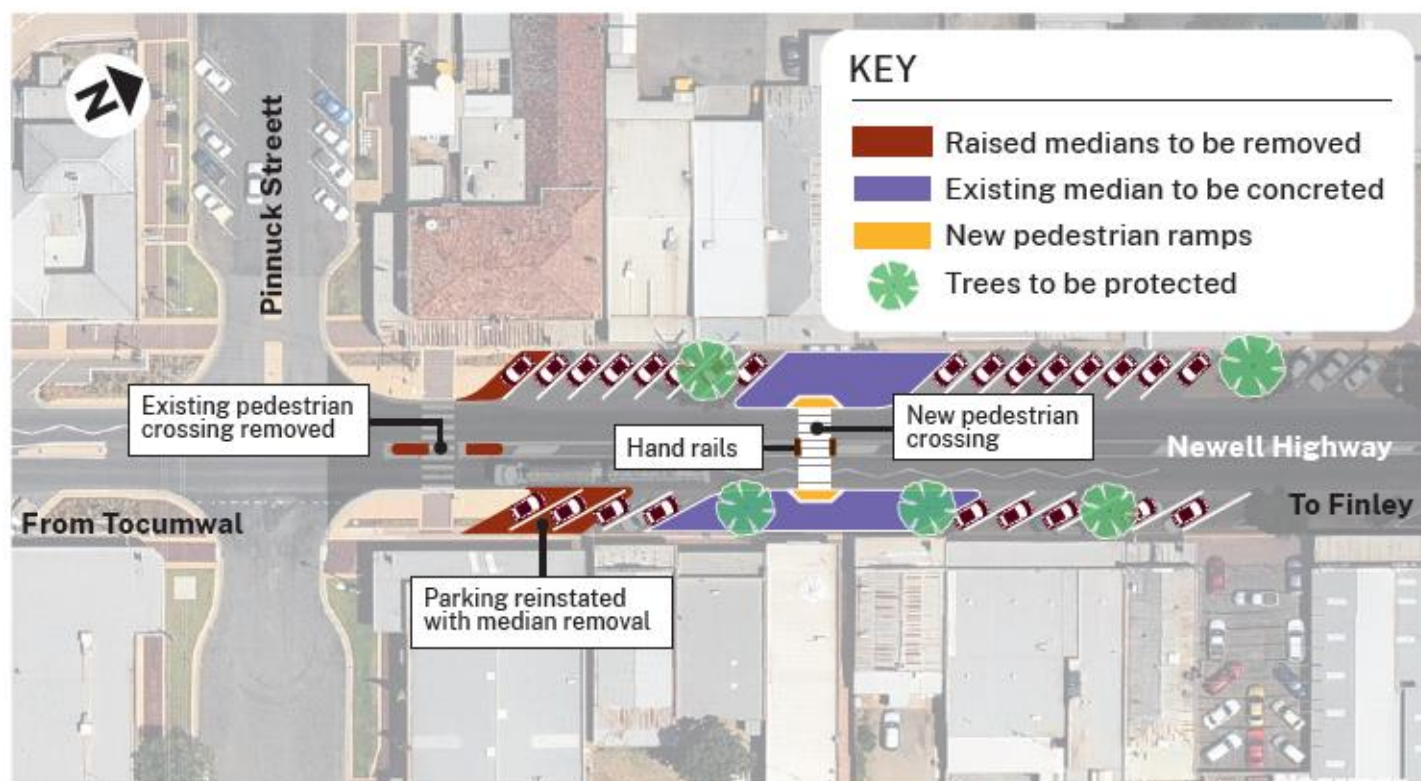


You may notice:
