Murray Street, Finley between Wollamai Street and Pinnuck Street

Berrigan Shire Council, in partnership with Transport for NSW, will be upgrading Murray Street, Finley, between Wollamai and Pinnuck Streets. These essential works aim to improve road safety, pedestrian access, stormwater drainage, and overall street appearance.

The project will be delivered in three stages:

- **Stage 1:** Road pavement works by Transport for NSW, starting **Thursday, 16 May 2025** (weather permitting)
- **Stage 2:** Footpath, pedestrian crossing, stormwater, watermains, landscaping, and accessibility upgrades by Berrigan Shire Council – beginning June 2025
- **Stage 3:** Final road surfacing by Transport for NSW – August 2025 (upon completion of works by Berrigan Shire Council)

Expected Duration: Approximately 3 months, weather permitting

We will aim to maintain access to businesses and homes. However, some vehicle access, parking, and driveway entry may be temporarily restricted. Traffic management and detours will be in place. All affected residents and businesses will be notified directly in advance of any changes.

A brief interruption to the untreated water supply (up to 4 hours) will occur during water main connection works. Affected properties will be notified ahead of time. After reconnection, please run taps briefly to clear any discolouration.
